CONDITIONS OF ENTRANCE

Drivers must bring with them:

- A current and appropriate driving licence
- Valid insurance for the vehicle and any trailers, implements etc.
- If you intend to carry passengers in a passenger carrying appliance, you must provide evidence that your insurers have endorsed your policy for such activity.
- Registration numbers on the tractor and any trailer, attached implement etc.
- Children must be accompanied by adults (children to sit on the inside of the trailer)
- Trailers must have sides, headboard and tailboard must be at least 470 mm above the surface a person is sitting on.

Drivers must always:

- Obey the Highway Code
- Make their vehicles as visible as possible
- Show consideration to other road users
- Be aware that the general public does not always appreciate how slow a vintage tractor travels
- Must not obstruct road junctions or private driveways when stationary
- Ensure their tractor is roadworthy, especially the break and steering systems
- Switch off tractor when unattended and remove keys
- Drive at a sensible speed and do not attempt to overtake other tractors on the run, except in an emergency
- If carrying a passenger on the tractor a passenger seat must be fitted
- If using a passenger carrying appliance (i.e link box), which is attached to the tractor, please ensure that this appliance is capable of transporting their passengers in fixed seats with safety rails.
- If towing a passenger carrying appliance (i.e. trailer) please ensure that the said appliance has safety rails fitted and also fit a safety chain in addition to the normal coupling.

There will be marshals in attendance on the day. It is essential that you obey their instructions.

Drivers please note that any unnecessary riding around on the tractors on the site prior to the event will not be permitted.

The code of practice is for the safety of you and those around you.

I hereby declare that I have read and accept the above conditions of entrance and I agree that I shall have no claim against the organisers for any damage to tractors, road users or other property during the event.
